	There is to be no flash photography anytime swimmers are on the blocks. No photography or recording, including cell phones, is allowed behind the blocks or in the locker rooms.	
Eligibility	This meet is open to all Y swimmers ages 8 and under. Swimmer's age as of December 1st, 2023 will apply for the entire meet.	
	No Times (NT) entries are acceptable for this meet. No deck entries will be permitted. C&P League teams will have priority should the meet be oversubscribed.	
	This meet may be limited in size so please ensure both entries and payment are received to insure complete entry to the meet.	
	All teams and coaches must be registered with YUSA and provide proof of current certification.

Rules	The latest applicable USA Swimming technical rules shall govern this competition. Only swimmers, coaches, officials and meet volunteers are allowed on the pool deck throughout the meet.	
	a. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. The use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.	
	b. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.	
	c. The Meet Director and host team reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.	

	Overhead (dive over) starts will be used for all events 50 yards or longer. Please make sure your swimmers understand how overhead starts are done. No Recall Procedures: The no-recall rule will be in effect for this meet (USA Swimming Rules, Article 101, Section 102.14.4.H). Facility Rules: All swimmers MUST dry off, have clothing AND shoes upon leaving the pool area!! The hallways MUST stay as dry as possible.
